Refrigerators and freezers, dry paint cans, appliances (stoves, washers, dryers, etc.) Bath tubs, sinks, toilets, etc., bags of clothes, bags of toys, bedding, sofas, chairs, mattresses, box springs and metal springs. **Please limit to 2 yards per household.**

Anything refused must be removed from the curb by dark on Friday, September 29.
