

**LOCAL LAW NO. 1 OF 2018**

**LOCAL LAW AMENDING SECTION 14: ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES PROHIBITED, OF LOCAL LAW NO.2 of the year 1998**

**BE IT ENACTED** by the Village Board of Trustees, of the Village of Middleville, NY as follows:  
Section 14. Alcoholic Beverages Prohibited, Local Law No. 2 of the year 1998 shall now read as follows:

Section 14. Alcoholic Beverages Prohibited: No person shall consume, sell, offer for sale, or have upon his person while in said park, alcoholic beverages of any kind or nature, except by permit.

## **LOCAL LAW NO.2 OF 2018**

### **LOCAL LAW PROHIBITING ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ON MUNICIPAL PROPERTIES**

**BE IT ENACTED** by the Village Board of Trustees, of the Village of Middleville, NY as follows:

#### **SECTION ONE: ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES PROHIBITED:**

No person shall consume, sell, offer for sale, or have upon their person while on any property owned, leased or maintained by the Village of Middleville, alcoholic beverages of any kind, or nature, except by permit.

#### **SECTION TWO: PERMIT:**

Request for permission to allow for the consumption of alcohol on property owned, leased or maintained by the Village shall be submitted, in writing to the Village Board. The Village Board shall then vote on said request to determine whether the permit shall be issued.

#### **SECTION THREE: PENALTY FOR VIOLATION:**

Any person violating any provision of this ordinance shall for each and every violation thereof, and for each and every occurrence of such violation, be subject to a fine of not more than five hundred dollars (\$500.00), and may be barred or excluded from entering municipal property for a term to be established by the Justice of the local Court.
